

PRIVACY POLICY

The Prover vNext Platform, accessible through the mobile application Prover vNext and the Internet by the website www.provervnext.com.br (jointly referred as “Platform”), is owned and managed by COMP LINE TECNOLOGIA E INFORMÁTICA LTDA, with headquarters in the Corporate ParkShopping Building – Tower 2, Room 401, SAI/SO, Area 6580, Guar - Braslia/DF – 71.219-900, and Corporate Taxpayer’s ID (CNPJ/ME) no. 01.694.820/0001-93 (“Prover”).

Prover takes your privacy protection very seriously and complies with all applicable laws related to privacy and data protection. This Privacy Policy demonstrates how we handle your personal information.

Therefore, before continuing to use the Platform, we request you to carefully read the following text to know more about our Privacy Policy and to clearly express your consent to the ways we collect, use, store and process your personal data. This Privacy Policy is part of the Terms available at <http://www.provervnext.com.br/PrivacyPolicy.pdf> and will be applied to all users of the Platform (“Users”), registered or not. In case you have any doubts, please contact us through the channels indicated at the end of this Privacy Policy.

Registration. Your registration in the Platform must be made by means of the access to the Platform and the provision of certain personal data of yours. At the time of the registration, Prover may collect certain personal information from you, including, but not limited to name, email address, Individual or Corporate Taxpayer ID (CPF/CNPJ) and other data strictly necessary to the purposes detailed in this Privacy Policy.

Data Collection. In addition to the information provided at the time of the registration, we may collect information about the sections and pages accessed within the Platform and the way it is used. Furthermore, information such as your Internet browser type, device, hardware set or system configuration used to access the Platform, as well as your Internet Protocol address, may also be collected. Except as otherwise provided in this Privacy Policy, we will not have access to, neither attempt to access, your personal data, except those that you, freely, unequivocally and voluntarily provide using the Platform.

User Content. Documents submitted by the Users through the Platform (“User Content”) will not, at any case, be used by Prover to any purposes other than hosting and storing, according to the terms defined in the contracted plan. User Content is stored on Microsoft Azure’s servers with encryption and dual authentication methods.

How We Use your Information. We use the data obtained by the Platform exclusively for the purposes detailed above, according to the type of data:

- (i) **Personal Data:** to manage the security and reliability of Users’ accounts, to facilitate payments under the Platform, to answer Users’ questions regarding the Platform, to protect Prover’s and third parties’ rights and to forward communications relevant to the User about the products and services available on the Platform;

- (ii) Non-Identifiable Demographic, Collective and Technical Data: to manage and operate the Platform, to develop improvements and to optimize the Platform and to conduct researches and measurements.

Sharing and Disclosure of your Information. Your data and information may be accessed by a limited number of Prover's employees, by the companies involved in the credit operations used to make payments on the Platform and by Microsoft Azure, partner responsible for the Platform's storage and hosting services. Data and information inserted in the Platform are stored on servers owned by Prover and by Microsoft physically located in Brazil. However, Prover may in the future reallocate your information to servers located in any other country, for hosting, storage, support and/or backup purposes.

Prover's employees receive trainings about the importance of privacy and how to handle customers' data and manage them properly and securely. Prover also requires its Partners to keep your personal information confidential and not to use them for unauthorized purposes. In addition, you acknowledge and agree that your information may be shared with third parties to the extent necessary to allow us to merge, purchase or sell all our assets or part of them, under a confidentiality agreement. Also, we may provide your personal data and/or the User Content whenever allowed by applicable law and/or requested by any competent public authority or determined by a court decision. Anonymous or non-identifiable data provided by you (or collected from you as a result of your use of the Platform) may be shared with third parties to enable researches, measurements, statistics and other purposes at Prover's discretion.

Retention Term. Your personal data are kept by Prover for the time needed for the purposes set forth in this Privacy Policy, respecting the data retention period determined by applicable law.

Web Beacons and Cookies. The Platform may contain images known as web beacons (also referred as "single-pixel gifs") that allow Prover to count the number of Users of the Platform. Web beacons are not used to access your personal information, but are a technique used to account for collective statistics on the use of the Platform. Web beacons collect a limited set of data, including a cookie number, time and date of the visit to a website and a description of where the web beacon is located. For reference purposes, cookies are data packages related to non-personal information about the User, temporally stored in your computer. Web beacons, due to their technical characteristics, may not be disabled or rejected. As for the cookies, they may be disabled or may have their configuration altered in your browser. The User may contact his/her browser supplier in case he/she wants to change the settings related to the cookies. Prover uses cookies when the User access the Platform. Our cookies are uniquely associated to a User and to its respective access computer. Cookies enable Prover to recognize the User after having accessed the Platform, allowing the User to have a unique and personalized experience.

Your Right to Access to your Information.
